Brother Ports was active in California and national politics prior to his death in 1965.

The Alpha Tau Omega Foundation pays a \$150/week stipend, travel to and from Washington, D.C., and housing during the entire internship.

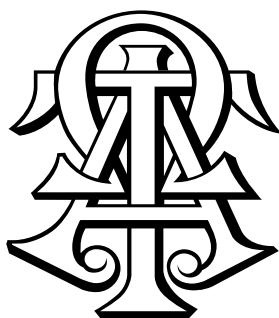
The ATO chosen to receive this internship will spend six to eight weeks in Washington, D.C. during the Summer or Fall of 2012.
